The ADAL Winn Army Hospital at Fort Stewart, Georgia is our feature job for this issue. McCarthy Building Co., Inc. served as the General Contractor for this job and Leo A. Daly is the architect. McCarthy's management team consisted of Dan Hesse – Project Manager and Malcolm Green – Superintendent. Key Ace personnel on the project were **Corey Hinson** – Project Manager, **David Brantley** – Superintendent and **Cliff Wheeler** – Estimator. Other Ace personnel contributing to this job included **Rashad Hall** and **Rodney Strobridge**. Ace's CAD/XY Technology and Preconstruction/Prefab department also played a big part in the success of this project.

The four-year project consisted of two large additions and renovations to other areas of the existing facility, all while the hospital remained open and fully operational. The two additions combined increased the size of the hospital by approximately 99,000 square feet. The first was a new dining facility and the second was a two-story emergency department. Renovations were completed in numerous areas including the ancillary care, outpatient, administrative departments and various support spaces. Ace's scope of work included electrical, fire protection, detection and alarm systems, utilities and site improvements.

The project is designed to achieve Energy Policy Act of 2005 (EPAC 2005) and LEED 3.0 Silver Certified ratings.
