

#### Feature Job



Our feature job for this issue is the HC-130J Simulator at Moody AFB in Valdosta, Georgia. **IKBI, Inc.** served as the general contractor. The management team consisted of Santiago Iturralde – IKBI's Project Manager, Jim Mobley - IKBI's Superintendent, **Matt VolIrath** - Ace's Project Manager and **John Herring** - Ace's Superintendent. Ace's estimator for this project was **Kevin Cowart**. Other Ace employees that worked on the job were **Bernard Jackson**, **Joe Montgomery**, **Travis Moore**, **Joey Perullo**, **Tavaris Sharp**, **Alan Shawver**, **Kelvin Slocumb** and **Eric Uneless**.

This design/build effort produced a 27,000 sq. ft. facility capable of housing two flight simulators in large, high ceiling bays. The building also contains administrative office space. Additional work included demolition of existing infrastructure, a new 100-space parking lot and extension/connection of all necessary utilities. This project is expected to achieve LEED Silver certification in the category of New Construction.
