Ace Electric, Inc. is pleased to showcase Lexington County Logistics Center in Lexington, South Carolina as the Feature Project for this issue of *Inside Ace*. Ace's Macon Division proudly served as electrical contractor for the project. The new one-story, 337,000 sq. ft. distribution facility and maintenance garage sits on an 80-acre site with over 27 acres of auto, truck, and van parking. The main building consists of approximately 15,000 sq. ft. of administrative office space while the distribution area houses over 200 vans and 82 dock positions. The building will be occupied both by FedEx Ground and FedEx Express to be used for sorting and distribution for vans and trucks.
